
IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING GRADUATION AND

END OF SCHOOL - Due to the abundance of snow days this year, our last day of school is now scheduled for **Friday 21st June** at **noon.** Graduation will now be held on **Thursday 20th June.**

CHARACTER DEVELOPMENT - This month's character trait is honesty! Honesty means: giving the correct idea or impression, keeping your word, honouring your commitments and returning what you borrowed. Honesty can also mean doing your own assignments and being real or genuine. Proverbs 12:17 says: 'an honest witness tells the truth, a false witness tells lies.' I choose to be honest, just like Jesus.

TIP OF THE WEEK - We need to treat our kids the way God treats us. The Bible says, "Casting all your care upon Him, for He cares for you (1Peter 5:7 NKJV). It's amazing how inclusive the word "all" is. It doesn't say



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that we are to cast only our legitimate cares on Him. Although He's a busy God with a lot on His plate, He's also an omnipotent God, so He's never too busy. Nevertheless, it would seem reasonable, at least from a human perspective, not to bother God with things that stem from our children's immaturity and lack of sophistication. Fortunately, God is a God of grace. He loves to give us things we don't necessarily deserve but desperately need. He knows we often lack perspective, but that doesn't stop Him from inviting us close to His heart. A good example of God's grace is not only the gigantic act of grace that Jesus showed by dying on the cross for our sins, but also the little acts of grace He demonstrated in the midst of His crucifixion. Soldiers, leaders, followers, and criminals got Jesus' individual attention when He had bigger tasks on His "to do" list. That's because God's grace notices vulnerable people. It's in constant tune with their hearts. Our children need this kind of grace. Their confusing lives cry out for our sensitive touch. God gives us just enough of a head start to bring perspective and understanding to the fragile needs of our kids. - Grace Based Parenting, pgs. 167, 168

BUS CANCELLATION/ SCHOOL CLOSURE - Unfortunately, inclement weather brings along with it the possibility of school closures. Please note that if Hamilton Public or Catholic Board cancels school busses (look online for

cancellation of Hamilton-Wentworth School Transportation), **SCHOOL WILL BE CLOSED.** Please check **your school email or Facebook** for school closures. Once we have been informed of cancellation by the bus company, we will post it to your email and Facebook by 6:45 am.

STUDENT DROP OFF - Please remember that <u>student</u> <u>supervision does not begin until 8:50 am</u>, unless a specific arrangement has been made with your child's class teacher for that day. Please remain with your children until that time, to ensure their safety. Thank you for respecting the staff devotional time.

STUDENT PICK UP - Please remember that **student supervision ends at 3:30 pm**, unless a specific arrangement has been made with your child's class teacher for that day. Please respect our time by picking your child up on time.
