To them, keeping their children balanced when it comes to their faith, integrity, poise, discipline, endurance, and courage makes more sense than worrying about whether others think their children look spiritual enough (whatever that means).

Grace-based parents don't make it a crime for their children to be different, or to be oddballs. In the process, they encourage their children to find the unique individual that God designed them to be through an intimate and authentic relationship with Christ - Grace Based Parenting, p. 212
