

Tip of the Week - CAN YOU TRUST YOUR KIDS?

Do you worry about what your increasingly independent kids are doing when they're out of your sight? Can they be trusted? Perhaps a more important question is, Can you trust their friends?

Regardless of how much you trust your own children, if they are running around with kids who do things you don't approve of, they'll probably yield to peer influence sooner or later. Begin early to tell your children, "I can trust you only as much as I can trust your friends." In addition, let them know that they have the power to influence their friends for good. Encourage them to be the 'thermometer' that measures the moral temperature.
