Tip of the Week - THE CUSHION OF LOVE

Love is the protective agent that can soften the blow of psychological harshness or unfair discipline that sometimes come from uptight, frustrated parents. The thicker the cushion, the easier it is for the child to understand that parents will make an occasional mistake, without the child being devastated.

A loved child is more likely to respond, "Dad sure got mad, but I know he didn't mean all those things he said", than a child who feels unloved. Let's face it, if you're like me, you want to be a good parent, but you sometimes say things without thinking. Or maybe you threaten, criticize, or impose consequences that are too severe.

I also hope you're learning from your mistakes, but because you're not yet prefect, I hope you've stored up a big cushion of love so your kids can bounce back without getting hurt. - Power Tips for Parents, p. 53
