

#### The Freedom to Make Mistakes

There is nothing in the realm of grace that gives anyone the license to ignore God's standards. If anything, grace should motivate you to a higher holiness.

Grace-based homes aren't places where family members assume they can say whatever they want, see whatever they want, hear whatever they want, taste or drink whatever they want, or touch whatever they want. That's not grace. That's someone wanting to live his or her own life with no regard for what God has said or what He thinks. But when grace is in place, there is clearly a different attitude toward sin than in homes without grace.

If I could summarize grace in one sentence, it would be something like this: "As long as you are pleasing God, you're pretty much free to do whatever you want/" But keep in mind that "pleasing" God is contingent on our faith in Him, not on our ability to maintain a righteous and moral standard, as so many assume. 1Hebrews 1:6 says, "Without faith it is impossible to please God."

People who walk by faith are far more capable of developing a godly and right-eous lifestyle because they are finding their power for living in their personal relationship with the Lord. - Grace Based Parenting, p. 214
