<u>UPDATE RE REPORT CARDS</u> - Report Card 1 will be sent home on Monday 1st March.

The government requires us to send 3 reports per school year - a Progress Report in November, Report 1 and a Final Report. We have been giving an additional Progress Report in April. However, due to the Ontario Conference transitioning to a new management information system called PowerSchool, there will not be a Progress Report 2 in April. Virtual Parent-Teacher Interviews will occur as planned in the evenings of April 27 - 29. Final Report Cards will be sent home on the last day of school.

ONLINE PARENTS - Please note that Thursday, 4th March and Friday, 5th March will be 'Learning Material Pick Up Days' for all **grade K** - **8 online students.** The teachers will have learning materials ready that the students will need for the next few weeks. A paper copy of your child's Report Card will also be included.


