TUITION PAYMENTS - Please continue to make your tuition payments on time each month. During the stay-at-home order, payments can be made as follows:

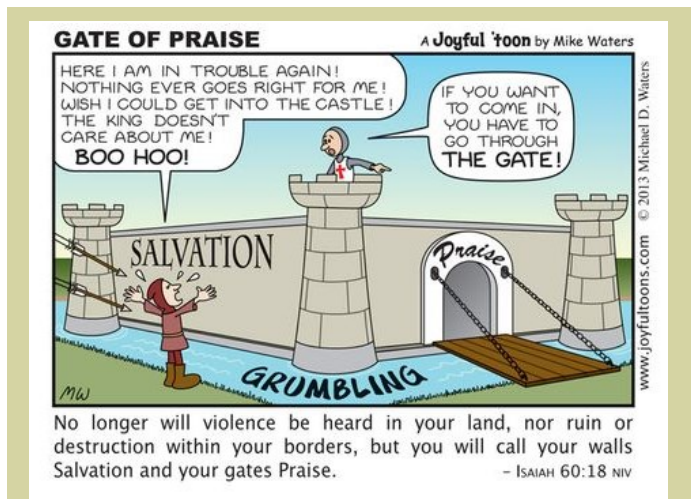
