

<u>PARENTS</u> - Please print out a copy of your child's online schedule and post it someplace where both you and your child can see it. This way there will be no question as to what class your child should be in and at what time.

<u>TUITION PAYMENTS</u> - Please continue to make your tuition payments on time each month. **June's payment is due on Tuesday 1st June.** During the stayathome order, payments can be made as follows:

Credit Cards - pay online at our website. Scroll to the bottom of the Tuition Fees page and you will see the link to pay the tuition. (No student number is needed.)

Please note, for those who are set up to have their payments taken from their credit card in the office, the secretary will continue to do this for the time being.

Debit Cards - For those unable to use a credit card, it is possible to 'Send an Interac e-transfer' from your bank's web page to the school's bank account. Please contact our Treasurer, Barb, by email at kozybee@gmail.com to set this up.

REGISTRATION 2021-2022 - Please note that due to COVID safety requirements, we are having to cap the classroom sizes for the 2021-2022 school year. As such, a waiting list may have to be introduced for some classes.

For those parents that paid the early registration fee, but did not send in the registration forms, please note that your child's registration is **not** considered **complete**. You must send/scan in the forms immediately or your child's spot may be forfeited!

MESSAGE TO PARENTS RE ONLINE LEARNING - When online, please make sure that your child is in an environment that is quiet, as they are often required to have their microphones unmuted. We have been experiencing some cases where teachers are able to hear others in the background. This disrupts the flow of the class and makes it quite impossible to teach.

Please also help your child, where necessary, to ensure that the setting on the camera is always on and that your child is always visible in class.

Please also make sure that your child is ready for learning with all the needed books and materials and arrives to class on time.

Thank you for addressing these issues and for helping to make sure that the necessary learning can take place online.
